




## Financial and economic system artificially preserved

Through direct intervention in the stock markets and the buying of shares, central banks also rescued companies that were floundering.

Thus the Swiss National Bank (SNB), among others, is now a major shareholder of Apple, Microsoft, Amazon and Facebook and held US shares worth 91 billion Dollars at end of 2017.
